### **Description:**

Leslie provides a writers' workshop presentation for students in grades 5-12. She introduces her novel and describes the process of writing a book. Then she provides instruction on strong, effective writing- creative and academic. This includes strategies and tips for all stages of the writing process. Additionally, there is an opportunity for practice with a short creative writing task. At several points during the presentation there is a raffle for students to win prizes related to writing and Leslie's book. She distributes free bookmarks and stickers to attendees.
